

# **USD #252 SOUTHERN LYON COUNTY BOARD MEMBER ELECTION BOUNDARY LINES:**

The board took action to have Superintendent Argabright draw up a resolution to change the Board Member Election boundary lines from three districts with two board members elected to two districts with three members elected and one elected at-large. The district is required to address the boundary lines if the population from the most recent census report in each district has a 5% or more difference. Our district currently exceeds 5%, therefore the Board is required to address and balance the election lines.

The proposed two districts will balance our current educational set up within Southern Lyon County. Each K-12 system will have three Board Members elected to represent their communities and attendance centers with one Board Member elected at-large to make up the total of seven members.

This proposed change **does not** affect where students attend school! It only affects how Board Members are elected with regards to the district area they represent.

The proposed change in the Method of Election (from three districts to two districts) will be brought to a vote by the patrons of USD 252 at the November general election.

### **CHANGE IN METHOD OF ELECTION TO TWO MEMBER DISTRICTS**

Shall the following change in the Method of Election be adopted?

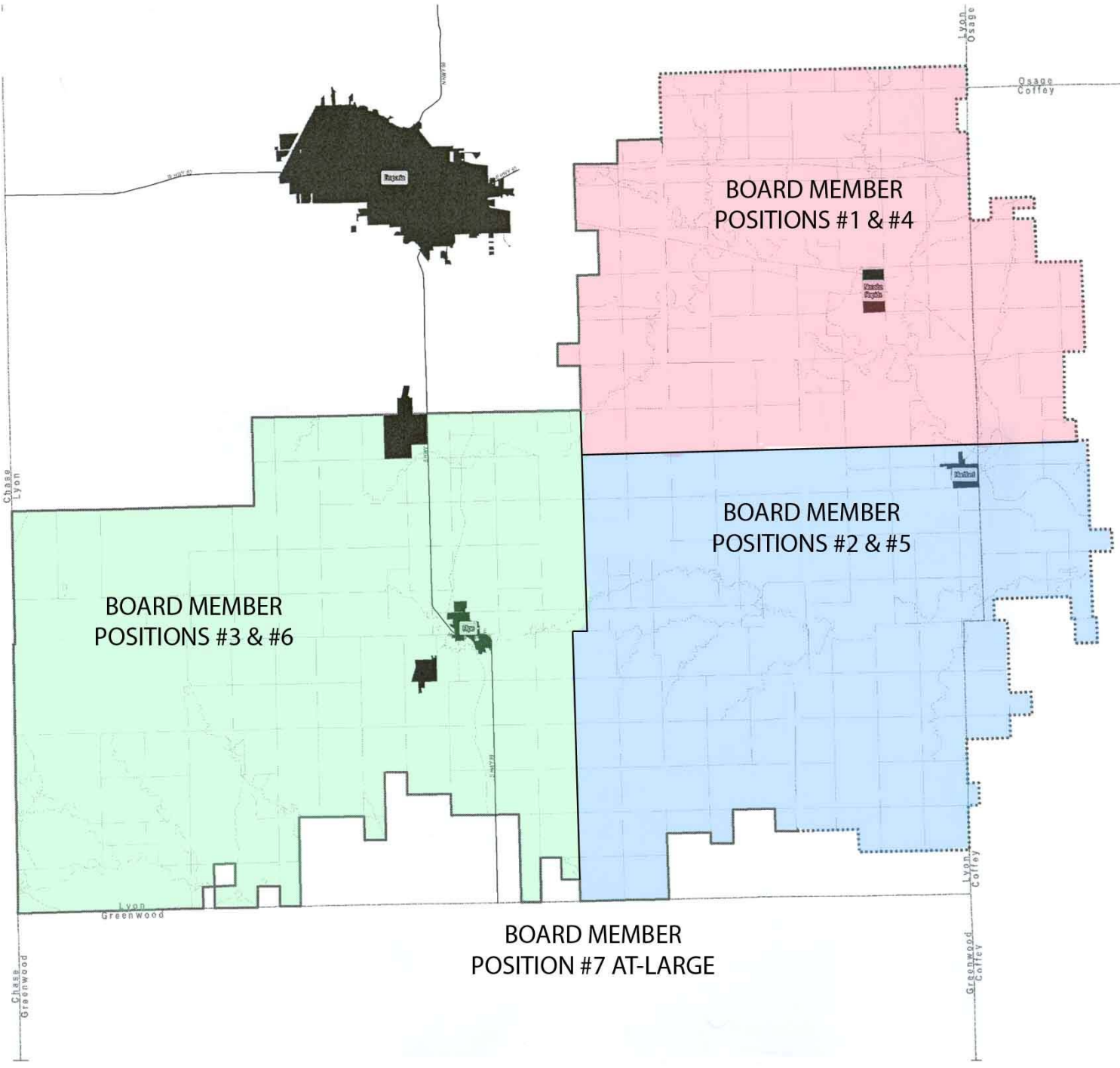
“Shall Unified School District No. 252, Southern Lyon County, Kansas change the method of election from the current three member district method under which the school district is divided into three member districts, in which two board members are elected from each member district and one board member is elected at-large, to the two-member district method of electing school board members under which:

The school district is divided into two member districts, in which three board members are elected from each member district and one member is elected at-large.

“Shall a change in the method of election as described in the ballot title above, be approved?”

To vote in favor of the method of election change vote ‘Yes’  
To vote against it vote ‘No.’
